SUPERINTENDENT NEWS

Fall Leaf collection: Leaves must be on the edge of the road for pick up. Leaf collection will begin **October 14th** and continue (weather permitting) **through November 14th**. Please rake the leaves to the curb, and the Village will clean them up. **You do not have to bag leaves in the fall.**

DO NOT PUT LEAVES AND BRUSH TOGETHER

Fall Brush clean up: All tree butts must face the street and be stacked in an orderly fashion. If brush piles are not stacked properly, village employees will not pick them up. **Brush will be chipped October 14th and November 14th, 2016(weather permitting).** We prefer brush to be placed next to curb/street no more than 48 hours prior to pick up. If you cut a large tree on private property, it is your responsibility to clean it up.



VILLAGE UPDATES & REMINDERS

- **Washington Street** is on schedule to be complete October 15th.
- Last day to **register to vote** is Tuesday, October 11th at 4 pm. Register at any Secretary of State office, County Clerk, or your Township Clerk office. Remember to **VOTE** Tuesday, November 8th.
- **Trick or Treating** will be Monday, October 31st from 6:00-8:00 pm. Parking is available at the Community Center and Sheridan Elementary.
- **Village Council Meeting** will be held Wednesday, November 9th at 7:30 pm due to the General Election.
- **Water/Sewer payments** may be deposited in the collection box next to the post office mail box between the Village Office and the Fire Barn.
- **Reminder**—Small recreational campfires in an enclosed fire pit is permissible, NO burning of garbage, yard refuse, papers, building materials, etc. is permitted.
- **Reminder**—there is NO PARKING on Village Streets from 2:00 am — 6:00 am during snow season. Also, please keep your sidewalks clear of ice and snow.
- **OPEN COUNCIL POSITON**—If you are interested in serving your village as a council member, you need to file as a write-in candidate in the General Election. Applications are available in the Village Office, or you may contact the County or Township Clerk. Write-in candidate deadline is 4:00 pm, October 28th.

I would like to thank everyone for their patience while Washington Street improvements are being made. The project includes new curb and gutters, sidewalks, replacing and relocating the water main into a green space, adding additional fire hydrants for improved coverage and repaving from Main Street to the Village limits. This project was funded in part through an MDOT grant and Bond issue. The project is scheduled to be completed mid-October.

On another note...The Carnation site is now an empty lot! The Village Council is working towards future plans for development and has begun consulting with agencies that specialize in economic and commercial development. This is a great location and a vital piece of property for Sheridan to develop and to bring new businesses into the area.

Work has already begun in the Village to access our Storm/Waste Water System. The engineering firm Fleis & Vanderbrink will be coordinating the project. The SAW Grant is funded through a MDEQ grant and will be completed over the next three years.
