SUPERINTENDENT NEWS

Leaf collection (Spring pickup): Leaves must be in bags. The Village DPW will pick them up.

Brush pickup (Spring pickup): All tree butts must face the street and be stacked in an orderly fashion. If brush piles are not stacked properly, village employees will not pick them up. **Brush will be chipped on the 15th of each month beginning April 15 until October 15, 2015 (weather permitting).** Also, if you cut a large tree on private property, it is your responsibility to clean it up.

* Please note the council recommends that to keep the road clear, brush should be out to the street on the 14th of the month. We prefer brush to be placed next to curb/street no more than 24 hours prior to the 15th of the month.

VILLAGE STREET REPAIR

The east alley is scheduled to be roto milled and repaved. Chip seal is scheduled for: Evergreen Street from Main to Oak; Fargo Street from Main to Pine; Pine Street from Fargo to Grant.
